

## California Proposition 65 Statement

Proposition 65 (Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) requires businesses to identify consumer products that contain chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm and provide clear and reasonable warnings to Californians about significant exposures. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water. Proposition 65 requires the state California to maintain and update a list of chemicals known to the state to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity.

Swissbit regularly monitors the content of its products to enable timely updates of material content information as new requirements are identified. Based on this information, Swissbit has determined that some Swissbit products contain one or more of the chemicals listed on Prop 65 list of **January 3, 2025**. However, Swissbit does not produce or distribute consumer goods. Therefore, our products are not within the scope of this regulation. When used as intended, Swissbit products do not expose people to Prop 65 chemicals or release these chemicals into the environment. For this reason, Swissbit does not provide a specific list of Prop 65 chemicals that may be contained in our products.

If, after reviewing the available material content and product information, we determine that there may be a risk of exposure to a Prop 65 chemical, Swissbit will provide the required warning to its customers including a list of the affected products and the Prop65 chemicals they contain.
