

TSCA Statement

Toxic Substances Control Act, Section 6(h)

Dear Valued Customer,

The Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) was administered by the EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) in 1976 and amended on January 6th 2021 concerning five final rules to reduce exposures to certain chemicals that are persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT).

These five PBT substance of concern under TSCA section 6(h) are:

Decabromodiphenyl ether (Deca BDE)	1163-19-5
Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP 3:1)	68937-41-7
2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)	732-26-3
Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)	87-68-3
Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)	133-49-3
