The Consumer Electronics Association (CEA®) announced the release of the revised “Joint Industry Guide – Material Composition Declaration for Electrotechnical Products –JIG-101 Ed. 4.1” an industry materials declaration guide that facilitates the reporting of material content information in electrotechnical products across the global supply chain.
